 - **More trained mainstream teachers & SSO's**
 - **More Special Education Classes in all DECS's schools (years R-3)**
- **More (and Smaller class size) Special Education Classes in all DECS's schools (years 4-7)**
 - **Start planning for Specialised ASD Education in all DECS's High schools – NOW!**
- **Special Autism Schools with intensive, early and ongoing behavioural type interventions**
- **Quicker roll-out of the DEEWR/AAETC Teacher and Staff development for working with children with Autism**
- **One-on-one early intervention programmes such as Applied Behavioural Therapy (ABA) at Kindergartens**
- **Mandatory Speech and Occupational therapy for all special needs toddlers & school children**
